Dairy Show Rules

The judge will select a Champion and Reserve Champion dairy animal.

- A. An exhibitor is limited to showing two animals.
- B. If a junior herd is shown, the three animals in the junior herd may be shown in individual classes.
- C. Registered and Grades will show together
- D. New classes of all breeds are as follows:

Junior calf (3-1-2008 to 4-30-2008)	Intermediate Calf (12-1-2007 to 2-28-2008)
Senior calf (9-1-2007 to 11-30-2007)	Summer Yearling (6-1-2007 to 8-31-2007)
Spring Yearling (3-1-2007 to 5-31-2007)	Winter Yearling (12-1-2006- to 2-29-2007)
Fall Yearling (9-1-2006 to 11-30-2007)	Dry Cow Any Age
Two Year Old (9-1-2005 to 8-31-2006)	3 year old (9-1-2004 to 8-31-2005)
Four Year Old (9-1-2003 to 08-31-2004)	Five + Year Old (Prior to 09-1-2003)

**Animals born after 8-31-06 that have calved must be shown as two-year olds.

Exhibitors in the Junior Herd class will enter three females. At least one of the three must be a cow that has freshened and has been fresh long enough to have a projected 305 day M.E. All three must be of the same breed. These must be pre-entered as a herd to qualify.

Option: All Dairy animals will be given the option of coming in on the day of the show and leaving after the show. If need be, the cow will be returned for Round Robin Showmanship. Stall space may dictate whether or not Dairy animals will be allowed to stay at the Fair for the entire week.
