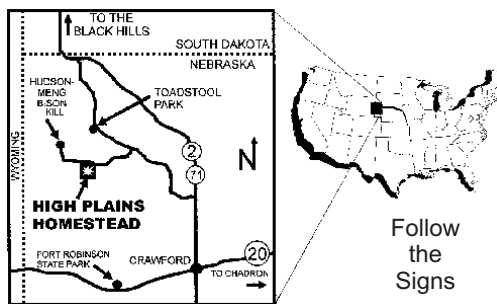
## Badlands Mercantile
